

Multiple Intelligences and Talents

I believe a good teacher recognizes the individual differences that distinguish their students from one another and they take account for these differences in their practice. Different students have different interests, different intelligences, different gifts. Whenever students complete projects, I allow students to express themselves in their own way. Here is an example of projects that allow students to demonstrate different multiple intelligences.

A Midsummer Night's Dream Projects

This is worth a test grade.

If you are to receive full credit—I expect you to put some work into this!

Select one of the following projects:

1. Design a movie poster—It needs to include a title, tagline, who the main actors are and which characters they are playing. You may not use pictures or actors from the movie that we are watching.
2. Create a soundtrack CD. Design the cover of the CD. Include a song to go with each scene of the play. Also, include a list of the song titles and an explanation of why they go with the scene.
3. Create a timeline with pictures, including all the events of the play. This must be poster size.
4. Create a mobile of all the main characters and be sure to label the pictures/illustrations. You may not use pictures or actors from the movie that we are watching.
5. Design costume sketches for the main characters and include an explanation/description of your choices.
6. Draw a poster-size map where all the events that take place.
